Letter to former BHS Students who qualify for diploma under Act 155

July 10, 2014

Dear Student:

The 2014 General Assembly passed Act 155 that was signed into law by the Governor on April 14, 2014. This law allows any student from 1990-2014 who did not graduate from high school solely for failure to pass the BSAP/HSAP exam to receive a diploma. To be eligible to receive a diploma under this law, a person must have met all other graduation requirements at the end of his/her high school attendance.

If you think that you should receive a diploma under this law, call the Broome High School Guidance Office immediately at 864-279-6701. Our school and district officials will order the diploma. The South Carolina Department of Education will not accept requests directly from the diploma candidate.

All petitions for a diploma under this law must be received by the district and sent to the South Carolina Department of Education before December 31, 2015. Therefore, we advise that you make your request to our high school guidance staff as soon as possible.
